Mrs. Lerda suggests extending the book read by using the following suggestions:

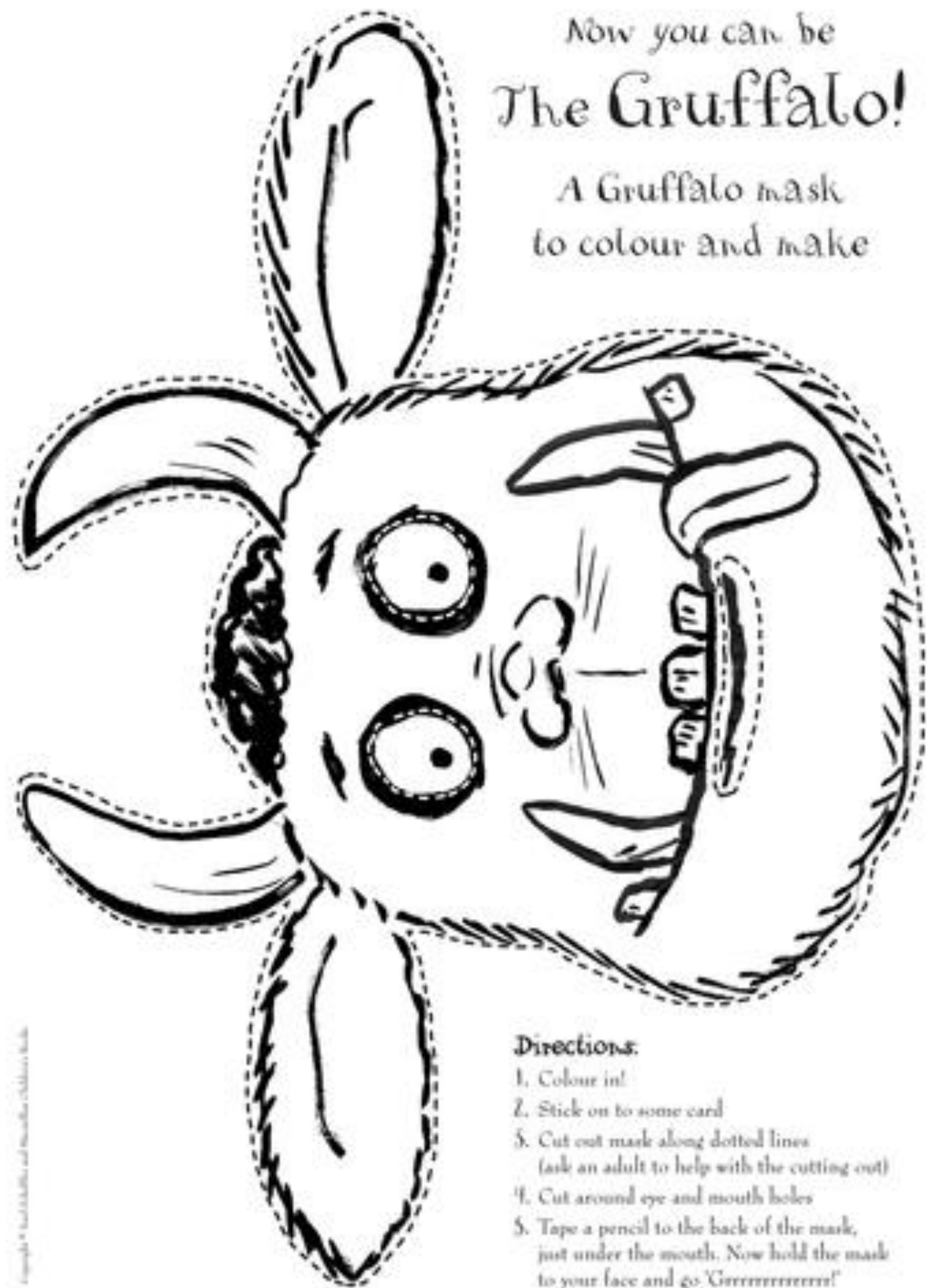
- Making a Gruffalo Mask, provided below
