Tissue Paper Cards

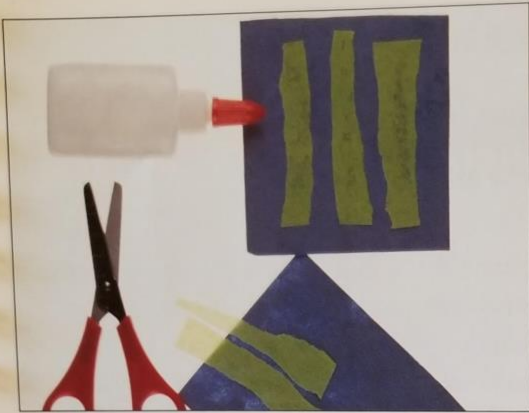
Tissue paper comes in such a wide range of colors, it is easy to tear and sticks with the minimum of glue. When decorating cards there is no end to the number of ways you can use tissue paper. These cards are made from torn strips

of tissue and layered to create blended colors and a simple design. The colors are bright and breezy and very stylish. Have a go at layering colors yourself. Create a natural looking landscape with torn or cut greens, blues and browns.

You will need:

- Colored paper
- Tissue paper
- Scissors
- Glue





1 Fold a piece of colored paper in half to form the card. Tear off pieces of lime green tissue paper and use small amounts of glue to stick them onto the card.



2 Now layer on strips of pink tissue paper and follow these with a border of blue tissue paper strips. When the glue has set, your card is ready for you to sign and send to a friend.



3 This eye-catching Valentine card is easy to make. You will need to layer 4 pieces of red tissue paper together, fold them in half, and carefully tear out a heart shape. The border of the card is made from scissor-cut pieces of red tissue paper.
